







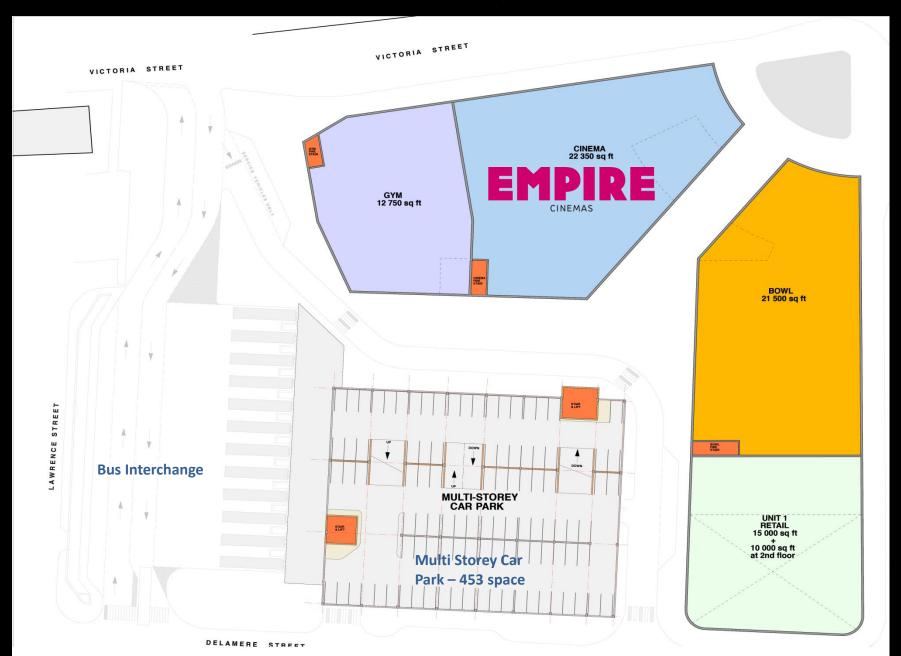

- Crewe largest town in Cheshire East with major growth expected
- Home to 5,000 businesses, 60,000 work based employees
- A new £15m Lifestyle Centre within 200m of the site
- Borough's first University Technical College is now open.
- Ranked 3rd best residential location in the UK, taking into account quality of life, employment levels, property affordability, local amenities, education and interest connectivity.
- 12,000 new homes to be delivered in Crewe between 2010 and 2030
- Significant growth, both homes and employment -Bentley Extension approved, New 60,000sqft HQ
- £27m investment to deliver Crewe Green Link Road Scheme
- £11.5m invested into Basford West Spine Road.
- Connectivity through transport infrastructure, M6 and Rail being the key drivers.
- New HS2 Hub in Crewe to operate 7 trains per hour, scheduled to arrive in 2027
